

TRAVELLING

Be careful and monitor the risk level for the spread of the coronavirus

For each risk level, the instructions for the previous level must also be followed. The higher the risk, the more careful we need to be. Together, we will find the solutions to keep the risk level as low as possible.

To prevent the spread of the coronavirus, our employees have to follow the recommendations below, and we ask **you** to do the same:

LOW RISK

- do not go on a trip if you are ill, take a COVID-19 test if you suspect you might have it
- download the health certificate or vaccination certificate before crossing the border
- read and follow exactly the instructions established in Estonia and the country of destination (reisitargalt.ee)

MEDIUM RISK

- when abroad, wear a mask indoors (except children under the age of 12)
- do not walk around with more than one person and keep a safe distance from other people
- you might have to self-isolate when returning to Estonia (depending on the infection rate of the country where you were)
- take a rapid COVID-19 test before and after the trip in accordance with the requirements of the country of transit and destination

HIGH RISK

- travel safely and get acquainted with the epidemiological situation at the destination before the trip
- when returning from the trip, take a COVID-19 test immediately
- strictly comply with the quarantine and self-isolation requirements
- when returning from the trip, work from home if possible

VERY HIGH RISK

- avoid travelling
- postpone trips that were supposed to take place when the risk level is very high
